

What is Jigger/Tungiasis?

Jigger, which is also called Tungiasis, is one of the Neglected Tropical Diseases, caused by female sand fleas invading the skin of the feet or other areas. Infection often occurs in bedrooms with earthen floors where there is dry, shady soil which is favorable for growing sand flea larvae and pupae. In some areas, there are cases of people being infected through infected animals such as pigs, cows, dogs, and cats. Jigger has many different names depending on the region, and is also not only called Tungasis, but also pulga de areia, niguá, pique, bicho do pé, bichodo porco or jatecuba, sand flea, and chigoe. So far the Caribbean, South America, and sub-Saharan Africa are thought to be the only affected areas, though collecting reliable data is still challenging.



Symptoms of Jigger

In the acute stage, symptoms such as inflammation, pain, and itching appear, and scratches from the itching often lead to bacterial infections and the formation of abscesses. In the chronic stage, symptoms such as ulceration, ascending neuritis, deformation, and tissue necrosis occur. These symptoms can lead to difficulty walking, trouble sleeping, and difficulty concentrating at school or work.

Treatment and prevention of Jigger infestations

The general treatment method is to physically remove the infested sand fleas, but there are various risks such as secondary infection when using unsterilized instruments. Only medical professionals with experience should perform the treatment. The surgical procedure also cause physical and mental pain. Because Jigger is a zoonotic disease, an One Health Approach is needed to reduce the number of incidences. Along with Jigger treatment, prevention is recommended, including spraying the floor with insecticide, sealing the soil, washing feet with soap daily, and treating infested livestock.

Composition

- Active ingredient: 3% Phenothrin
- Other ingredient: viscosity modifier, solvent, preservative, pH adjuster

Physical properties

- Appearance: white emulsion
- Feeling: Smooth texture without stickiness
- Odor: material odor

Direction for use

- 1. Apply an appropriate amount to the affected area.
- 2. After 12 hours have elapsed, remove or wash away the lotion.
- 3. Apply the lotion 2 times a week.



Precautions and warnings

Do not use in case of hypersensitivity to the ingredients of this drug. ● External use only. Do not use on the eyes and the mucous membrane. ● If rashes, redness, or itching of the skin after use, immediately discontinue use and consult a doctor. ● Avoid getting the product into your eyes. If it gets into your eyes, rinse immediately with cold or lukewarm water. If symptoms are severe, consult an ophthalmologist. ● Parental supervision is required when used on children. ● Generally, elderly people are prone to have complications or often use other medication, so use with caution. ● For pregnant women or women who may be pregnant, use only if the perceived therapeutic benefit is judged to outweigh the risk. ● If possible, avoid use on lactating women. If these women have no choice but to use the product, then they should avoid breastfeeding.

Storage conditions and handling conditions

Store at room temperature. ■ Keep away from direct sunlight. ■ Keep out of reach of children. ■ Do not transfer the product to other containers. This may result in misuse or deterioration of product quality. ■ Do not use the product past the expiration date.
